  - v) catalysts;
  - vi) catalyst bypass mechanisms;
  - vii) flue gas exit;
  - viii) door and catalyst bypass gaskets;
  - ix) outer shielding and coverings;
  - x) fuel feed system; and
  - xi) blower motors and fan blade size.
- 3. final test report prepared by the testing laboratory; and
- 4. a copy of the operation and maintenance instructions.
